The abstract must include

- **Title;**
- **Author(s); if more than one, please mark presenter with an asterisk (*); Affiliation of (each) author;**
- **Summary of presentation;**
- **The abstract should be complete and informative (objectives, methods, results, conclusions);**
- **The text should have a maximum length of 200 words (font Arial, size 11);**
- **Line drawings, figures, graphs, charts, etc, should not be included.**
- **Author(s) wishing to present more than one abstract must submit separate submission forms;**
- **Abstract(s) submitted by students should be reviewed beforehand by their supervisor(s).**
