
In general, there are two types of stor tools named for the method of produ tion. Chipped stone tools are manufa tured by carefully chipping away bits stone to achieve the desired shape. Chipped stone tools can be made with very sharp edges or points and were used for hunting, food preparation a building shelters.

Ground stone tools are made by grine ing, shaping and smoothing the stone Ground stone tools were used to grin food or other substances. Weapons, such as axes and clubs, could also be made using the grinding technique.


